Conditions of Entry

1. The competition will be swum under ASA Law and ASA Technical rules.
2. Ages are as at age on day of competition
3. Entry fees of **£4.00** per individual event are payable to White Oak Swimming Club (WOSC). Entry fees will be returned if for any reason an entry is not accepted.
4. Entries should be made on the official entry form, which may be photocopied. They can be posted to (**Linda Condon, 1, Roselands, London Road, West Kingsdown, Sevenoaks, Kent. TN15 6ER**) or emailed to **entries@wosc.co.uk**
5. Entries may be restricted at the discretion of the organisers and will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entries will be seeded into heats from the times submitted.
6. Closing date for entries is midnight **Wednesday September 15th September 2010**
7. A maximum of two coaches' passes will be issued per club @ **£10.00** per pass. Only holders of these passes will be allowed on poolside. Please note that lunch is not provided for club coaches.
8. A set of results will be sent to each club after the meet and the results published on the White Oak website www.wosc.co.uk
9. There will be two sessions as shown on the programme of events. 50m events will have finals all others will be heat declared.
10. This will be a card less Open, therefore all swimmers will be assumed to be present to swim unless removed by the team manager/coach. Please see Removal Form document to be completed and handed to White Oak official/steward before the start of each session.
11. The pool is available for warm up only during the designated times. During the warm up, swimmers and coaches must ensure that they (and the swimmers in their charge) take no action that would endanger themselves or others. The instructions of the warm up marshals, or others in authority, must be obeyed immediately. Diving is not permitted in the warm up until sprint lanes are announced and then only in the designated sprint lanes under the supervision of club coaches.
12. Swimmers in the first two events of each session must present themselves to the whipping area at least 10 minutes before the start of the session. All other swimmers must report to the stewards at least two events before the start of their event. Failure to report to the stewards may result in the swimmer not being allowed to swim in their event.
13. Competitors are only allowed on poolside during the session in which they are competing. Appropriate footwear and clothing **MUST** be worn at all times away from poolside. Swimwear is not acceptable attire except on poolside. The diving pit and the teaching pool are out of bounds at all times.
14. Over the top starts may be in operation at the discretion of the referee.
15. Awards will be made to the top six swimmers in all age groups. Awards will also be made to Top Boy, Top Girl and Top Club. (Points are given as follows: 6 points for first place down to 1 point for sixth, for the top boy and the top girl and top club is the points gained by each club swimmer in the top six.)
16. The pool is 25 metres long with anti-wave lane ropes. Electronic timing will be used.
17. Admission to spectators is **£5.00 per programme for the day if paid in the morning or £3.00 for the afternoon session. £2.00 will be refunded after the first session if a spectator does not wish to attend the second session.**
18. The promoter reserves the right to alter the schedule if circumstances demand.
19. Entries and results will be managed on a computer. By submitting an entry, consent is given as required under the Data Protection Act 1984 to the holding of personal information on a computer.
